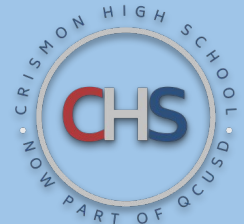


# Crimson's Vision

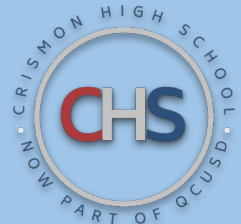


# Crimson's Core Values

**Service:** Rattlers pull up those around them rather than solely focusing on themselves.





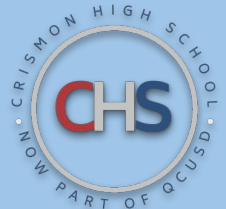
