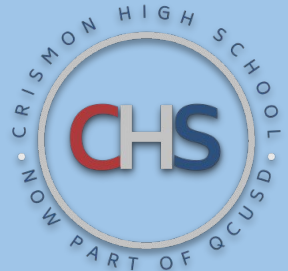

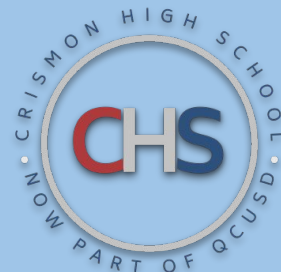

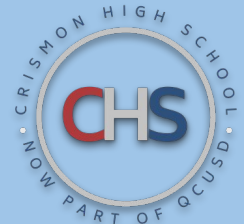


Crismon's Vision

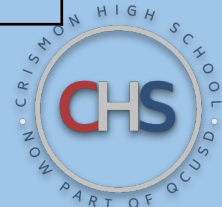

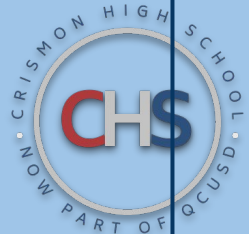

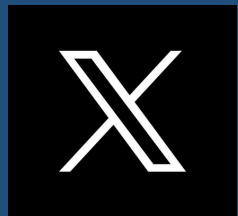
